

## Nomination of SOS Board Members

If you are interested in being considered for an SOS Board Member position you must apply for the position. The process for consideration is the following:

- Meet the required qualifications
- Evaluate your skills as compared to the recommended qualifications.

- Online submission is recommended

Five (5) at large members elected by a majority vote of the Board of Advisors of the A.C.S.C. to serve three (3) year terms. They shall serve staggered terms with three (3) elected for a three (3) year term and two (2) elected for a three (3) year term. The election for these positions shall take place at the Mid-Winter meeting. The duties of the SOS Board members are included in the SOS By-Laws Article 2, Section 2. - A Past President of an ACSC Shag Club
- Prior experience serving on an ACSC or SOS Committee
- Regular Attendance at SOS Events
