In addition, I have also chaired an Icon selection committee for RCSC and have chaired and/or been a member of multiple nominating committees leading to the selection of RCSC officers.

Narrative to highlight qualifications and skills

As required by the Nominating Committee, a standing committee of the ACSC/SOS board, I am officially submitting my application of interest for an SOS board member seat. I am currently a member in good standing of Rutherford County Shag Club, Shelby Shaggers, Sandy Beach Shag Club, R & B Shag Club, and OD Shag Club. In addition, I serve on the board of Rutherford County Shag Club as Immediate Past President. RCSC is considered to be my home club. I was honored to receive an ACSC Icon award in 2020 representing RCSC for my dedication to the shag community.

As a founding club member and board member of Rutherford County Shag Club I served on the planning team starting in the fall of 1991 until our first official dance in September of 1992 and helped build Rutherford County Shag Club from

the ground up. I was officially the club's first secretary for 1992- 1993 and 2nd president for 1993- 1994. I have served continuously either as an officer or committee chair from the early days and continue to serve on our board for 2025-26 as immediate past president. I have served on every RCSC committee and chaired most of them at least once and some of them multiple times. I have been president multiple times serving in good times and also lean years. As a thirty-year veteran of the public-school system I developed leadership skills, planning skills, and problem- solving skills while teaching middle schoolers, specifically 7th grade.

As an SOS committee member, I helped count votes during two previous elections and served as an ambassador in 2017 on a welcome committee introduced by past Chairman, Robin Morley. I have represented RCSC at many ACSC/SOS meetings including previously held Summer workshops in July and previously held February Winter workshops as a delegate representing RCSC.

As an SOS Board Member, I was elected in September at the Fall 2025 ACSC/SOS workshop to fill a vacant one- year board position. I have learned only a small part of what the ACSC / SOS board members have to do behind the scene to keep ACSC growing and SOS running smoothly for its many participants. I would like to be considered for an official, full three- year term so that I can continue to learn and know how this beautiful organization thrives and survives its many challenges.

I began attending SOS in the fall of 1993 while it was still a four-day event. I attended both Spring Safari and Fall Migration events in 1994. I attended my first ten-day SOS event after I retired from the public-school system in 2013. I have enjoyed many ten-day events since that time.
